CHICKEN ORDERS

ALL Chicken Orders are due by October 3rd.

For the Eastland County Stock Show, orders will contain 25 birds and cost \$78.25.

County show orders can be split by multiple 4-H members or families.

For any major shows, orders will contain 25 birds and cost \$37.50.



Information on pick-up dates will be sent to each ordering family as it becomes available.





VALIDATION TAGS & UINS



SHEEP & GOAT VALIDATION TAGS

Orders are due by August 19th

\$15 per tag

Tags will not be ordered until payment has been received in full

HEIFER UINS

Orders are due by September 1st

\$15 per UIN

UINs will not be ordered until payment has been received in full

Note: Once validated, heifers remain eligible through their show career unless they change breed or ownership.

You do not need to re-validate your heifer if the ownership or breed has not changed since last year's validation.

SWINE VALIDATION TAGS

Orders are due by September 19th

\$15 per tag

Tags will not be ordered until payment has been received in full
