

## Eastland County 4-H Letterman Leadership Award

The Letterman Leadership Award is open to all 4-H members in grades 3-12. There is no limit to the number of years a 4-H member can receive this award. 4-H members who do not submit an application will not be considered for this award. The application consists of a points-based checklist (see below) and a written response (see page 16). Both portions of the application must be submitted for consideration. Items 1-6 of the checklist are required to be eligible for this award. Items 7-10 are encouraged to be completed but are not required. Checklist and application should detail activities, involvement and projects from the **current 4-H year only**. Activities, involvement and projects from previous years will not be accepted.
