

## STEER & HEIFER VALIDATION TAG ORDERS



Steer & Heifer Validation Tag orders are due Wednesday, March 15th.

Tags are \$25 each

Tags will not be ordered until payment has been received in full.

New in 2023: All validated heifers will be tagged

\*Heifers already validated do not need to be revalidated or tagged.

\*Heifers only need to be revalidated if they change ownership/breed.

\*If your heifer has a previously existing 840 premise ID tag, it will be retagged with an official Texas Validation 840 tag.
