- All major show sheep must be at validation (market & breeding)
- All major show goats must be at validation (market & breeding)
- All market county show sheep must be at validation
- All market county show goats must be at validation
- Breeding county show sheep do not need to be at validation
- Breeding county show goats do not need to be at validation
- Registration papers must be in the exhibitor's name and must be brought to validation

Heifer Validation:

Saturday, October 21st 8AM @ Cattle Exchange Sale Barn

- All county show heifers must be at validation
- All major show heifers must be at validation
- Registration papers must be in the exhibitor's name and must be brought to validation

Pig Validation:

Tuesday, November 14th 2PM—6PM @ ECLRA Show Grounds

- All major show pigs must be at validation (market & breeding)
- All county show pigs must be at validation (market & breeding)
- Registration papers must be in the exhibitor's name and must be brought to validation

Rabbit Validation:

Tuesday, December 12th 4PM—6PM @ ECLRA Show Grounds

- All market rabbits must be at validation
- Breeding rabbits do not need to be at validation, but <u>must text</u> TJ Cummings at 254-488-1249 with the following information: Exhibitor's name and each rabbit's breed, age, sex and tattoo.

23-24 4-H YEAR UPDATES & RULE CHANGES



- Clover Kids will now have a \$10 enrollment fee.
- 4-H Members will have a \$25 enrollment fee until October 1st. The fee will increase to \$30 on November 1st. Volunteers will have a \$10 enrollment fee.
- All club leaders, assistant club leaders, project coaches, bank account signers and others who would like to help at meetings, practices, or community service events, MUST enroll in 4-H as a volunteer and complete the trainings and background screening.
 - ⇒ Parents who plan to only observe are not required to enroll but are highly encouraged to.
- All 4-H members must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at club meetings, project practices, community service events and when visiting the Eastland County Extension Office
 - ⇒ If a member's parent/guardian is unavailable, other arrangements must be made to have the member accompanied by a responsible adult.
 - ⇒ Members cannot be dropped off they must always be accompanied by a parent/guardian or other responsible adult.
- Eastland County Extension Agents and Office Staff will not be able to provide transportation to 4-H members to or from any meetings, practices, contests, or events.
 - ⇒ Transportation can possibly be provided by other approved 4-H volunteers, if available, to district contests/events this MUST be arranged through the Eastland County Extension Office to ensure all guidelines are followed.
- ALL club fundraisers, donation requests and community service projects MUST be approved and arranged by the Eastland County Extension Office
 - ⇒ Donation requests MUST come from the Eastland County Extension Office on official Extension/4-H Letterhead
