## **Eastland County 4-H Rookie Award**

The Rookie Award is open ONLY to members who are in their FIRST YEAR OF 4-H.

The years spent as a Clover Kid do not apply to this award.

Applicants must be in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or above. Members entering 3<sup>rd</sup> grade with prior Clover Kid membership are eligible to apply.

A member who has previously been in 4-H and rejoined or transferred here from another county is not eligible for this award.

4-H members who do not submit an application will not be considered for this award.

The application consists of a point-based checklist (see below) and a written response (see page 8). Both portions of the application must be submitted for consideration.

Items 1-4 of the checklist are required to be eligible for this award. Items 5-8 are encouraged to be completed but are not required.

Checklist and application should detail activities, involvement and projects from the **current 4-H year only**. Activities, involvement and projects from previous years will not be accepted.
