

#### **Educational Presentations:**

Educational Presentations are open to individuals or teams of two. Educational Presentations are limited to 12 minutes, with 9 minutes for setup and cleanup. Following the presentation, there will be 5 minutes for the judges to ask questions. The use of charts, photographs, computer presentations, graphics/programs, and other visual materials are permitted. A laptop, extension cord, projector and easel will be provided. The contestant will be responsible for all other materials and equipment.

#### **Public Speaking:**

Public Speaking presentations are limited to 5-9 minutes and should be suitable as a platform speech or radio broadcast. Point deductions will be taken for presentations under 5 minutes or over 9 minutes. Following the presentation, there will be 5 minutes for the judges to ask questions. Visual aids and props are not permitted.

#### 4-H Talent Showcase:

4-H Talent Showcase is open to individuals or teams of up to nine members. 4-H Talent Showcase presentations are limited to 6 minutes, with 4 minutes for setup and cleanup. Props are allowed. All props and equipment are the responsibility of the 4-H member; no equipment or props will be provided.
