There is no limit on the number of project forms a member can complete and turn in.

Clover Kids may complete project forms and receive recognition as well.

- 3. What did you learn completing this project?

Applicants should be making a positive difference in their communities through community service and the promise of their character and leadership. Through these works, they are helping make the world a better place for all.

I Dare You! Award recipients will receive a copy of William H. Danforth's classic motivational book, *I Dare You!*, and an invitation to the National Leadership Conference hosted by the American Youth Foundation.

The application consists of a one-page essay, single spaced, font no smaller than 10 point, and a statement or quote from a 4-H volunteer, teacher, pastor or community leader detailing how others are impacted by your leadership and community service.

Please attach the statement(s) or quote(s) to your essay upon submission.

The essay should address the following questions:

- 1. How have you been involved with 4-H at various levels (club, county, district, state)?
- 2. How has 4-H helped you reach your true potential?
- 3. How have you served your community through community service or as a leader?
- 4. How will you use the skills that you have gained in 4-H for future endeavors?

The Senior Spotlight is open to any 4-H members who graduated during the current 4-H year.

4-H members who complete and submit the Senior Spotlight Form will be recognized at the banquet and on our social media pages.
