(All major and county, breeding and market, pigs must be present.)

Rabbit Validation:

Tuesday, December 17th @ 4PM-6PM @ ECLRA Show Grounds

(All market rabbits must be present. Breeding rabbits do not need to be present but must text the following information to TJ Cummings at 254-488-1249: Exhibitor's name and each rabbit's breed, age, sex and tattoo.)


