VALIDATION TAG ORDERS



Steer & Heifer Tags

Tag orders & payment are due Friday, March 21st. Tags are \$30 each.

This is the **ONLY** validation opportunity for Steers for the Fall 2025 shows and the Spring 2026 shows. There will not be another steer validation later in the year.

For Heifers, this validation will cover the Fall 2025 show season.
There will be another opportunity to order tags in August and validate in October.
Once validated, heifers remain eligible for their entire show career, unless they change breed or ownership.

Fall 2025 Show Season Sheep & Goat Tags

Tag orders & payment are due Monday, March 31st. Tags will be \$15 each.

This validation will cover the Fall 2025 show season. All market and breeding sheep & goats must be validated for major stock shows.

Market projects validated in June for the Fall 2025 show season are also validated for the Spring 2026 show season, unless there are changes.

If any tags (including TLBA/TGBA) are added or changed, or if there is a change in breed or ownership, the project must be completely revalidated.

Breeding projects are validated for a three-year period; unless there are changes in tags, breed, or ownership, they do not need to be validated every year.

There will be another opportunity to order validation tags in August and validate in October for those who only plan on showing in the Spring 2026 show season.

Fall 2025 Show Season Pig Tags

Tag orders & payment are due Friday, April 15th. Tags are \$18 each.

This validation will cover ONLY the Fall 2025 show season. All market and breeding pigs must be validated for major stock shows.

There will be another opportunity to order validation tags in September and validate in November for those who plan on showing in the Spring 2026 show season.

We can accept cash (must be the exact amount) or check/money order (made payable to "Eastland County Ag Fund". We cannot accept card/virtual payments.

Educational Presentations:

Educational Presentations are open to individuals or teams of two. Educational Presentations are limited to 12 minutes, with 9 minutes for setup and cleanup. Following the presentation, there will be 5 minutes for the judges to ask questions. The use of charts, photographs, computer presentations, graphics/programs, and other visual materials are permitted. A laptop, extension cord, projector, and easel will be provided. Presentations should be in some form of Microsoft Office. The contestant will be responsible for all other materials and equipment. Take into consideration that internet connectivity will not be available.

Public Speaking:

Public Speaking presentations are limited to 5-7 minutes and should be suitable as a platform speech or radio broadcast. Point deductions will be taken for presentations under 5 minutes or over 7 minutes. Following the presentation, there will be 5 minutes for the judges to ask questions. Visual aids and props are not permitted.

4-H Talent Showcase:

4-H Talent Showcase is open to individuals or teams of up to nine members. 4-H Talent Showcase presentations are limited to 6 minutes, with 4 minutes for setup and cleanup. Props are allowed. All props and equipment are the responsibility of the 4-H member; no equipment or props will be provided. There will be no piano provided. Take into consideration that internet connectivity will not be available.
